Jheric Hizon is a pioneer in the Vancouver street dance scene, having taught many of Vancouver's hip hop teachers. He maintains a hectic schedule as an international dance instructor, choreographer, adjudicator, and performer.

He was chosen to choreograph and perform in the Vancouver Olympics 2010 Closing Ceremonies. Other performances include The Black Eyed Peas, Dance Delight, Concert openings, Mercedes Benz, Nike Presto, Disney Radio and Ayumi Hamasaki (Japan's Queen of Pop). Apart from dancing, he has appeared in several television shows, commercials, documentaries and a feature film.

Along with his performing career, he's had the privilege of judging and teaching over 30,000 dancers across North America and Southeast Asia at dozens of dance studios, conventions and competitions. Jheric specializes in Hip Hop and Breaking. He is a member of the Now Or Never Break Dance Crew, who won the title of Canadian Breaking Champions in 2008. They represented Canada, competing with 20 other countries in front of an audience of 25,000 people and placed among the world's best break dance crews at Battle of the Year International Germany (the world's largest break dance battle).

ROWENA "Roro" CACAPIT Roro was a self-taught street dancer when she began her career coaching, managing and choreographing at the age of 14. She currently shares her love of dance as a professional dancer, instructor, adjudicator and choreographer. She directs and choreographs several award winning teams and has won various choreography and scholarship awards, however, awards and winning have never been important to her.

Mikhail Baryshnikov's quote, "I do not try to dance better than anyone else. I only try to dance better than myself," is a quote she bases her whole career on and hopes to spread this to all of her students.

STEPHANIE BOURGETEL Stephanie is most passionate about life. She moved to Vancouver in 2013, where she joined the Goh Ballet Youth Company. After intense training in a broad range of styles, from Classical Ballet, to Jazz, and street styles, Stephanie focused on teaching. She teaches Ballet, Contemporary, Lyrical, & Jazz. Most recently she acquired her 200-Hour Teacher Training Certificate, and her 70-Hour YHot Teacher Training Certificate, from YYoga Teacher's College. Stephanie believes that learning requires dedication with times of laughter, and has a strong belief that every student is capable of achieving great things.

JENNA ESCOBIDO Jenna Escobido has been trained in hip hop for 8 years at Fresh Groove Productions. She has had the opportunity to perform all over the lower mainland, Disney Land, and has competed and won in many competitions all over North America. She has been teaching and coaching competitive groups for 4 years and teaches at her former high school and multiple elementary schools and preschools. TRAVIS LIM Travis Lim started dancing, acting and singing when he was 5 years old and has been training professionally in hip hop dance ever since. He has held the Gold medalist of Dance World Cup Canada for ten consecutive years; and at the World HipHop dance Championships and IDO World Street Dance Championships in United States, Italy and Austria, he has been crowned World Champion 5 times! He is the ambassador of Canada giving lectures and speeches about HipHop dance; and has taught dance workshops at the the 50th World dance Congress in Japan. He has hosted a 13 episode TV series on Shaw TV and recently has been cast on the "World Of Dance" season 2 on NBC Chanel Produced by Jennifer Lopez. Travis Lim is a very well-respected for his kindness, knowledge, generosity, and for being a good team player and a great team leader.
