OUR FACULTY

Anita Perel-Panar, M.A. Artistic director & CO-OWNER

Anita Perel-Panar has been educating children in music, dance and drama for over 30 years. Her fascination with creativity, imagination, inherent motivation, human nature and actualizing human potential led to completing her Bachelor of Arts degrees in English, Music and Drama. She completed her Masters of Arts degree with a thesis on The Development of Artistic Awareness in Children. She has extensive training in Ballet and other forms of dance.

Anita's passion for the arts, coupled with her love for teaching, led her to establish A Star Studio, A Star Productions, A Star Society and Boogaloo Academy.

Her dream to integrate the arts where students can develop their creative, expressive, and physical potential is now a reality. She is thrilled to be working with talented and dedicated teachers who share her vision and join her in providing an excellent education for all of our Boogaloo Academy/A Star Society students.

Jheric Hizon (B-Boy "Twist") Artistic Director & CO-OWNER

Jheric Hizon is a pioneer in the Vancouver street dance scene, having taught many of Vancouver's hip hop teachers. He maintains a hectic schedule as an international dance instructor, choreographer, adjudicator, and performer.

He was chosen to choreograph and perform in the Vancouver Olympics 2010 Closing Ceremonies. Other performances include: The Black Eyed Peas, Dance Delight, concert openings, Mercedes Benz, Nike Presto, Disney Radio and Ayumi Hamasaki (Japan's Queen of Pop). Apart from dancing, he has appeared in several television shows, commercials, documentaries and a feature film.

Along with his performing career, he's had the privilege of judging and teaching over 30,000 dancers across North America and Southeast Asia at dozens of dance studios, conventions and competitions. Jheric specializes in hip hop and breakin'. He is a member of the Now Or Never Break Dance Crew, who won the title of Canadian Breaking Champions in 2008. They represented Canada, competing with 20 other countries in front of an audience of 25,000 people and placed among the world's best break dance crews at Battle of the Year International Germany (the world's largest break dance battle).

Mackenzie Anderson

Mackenzie Anderson is originally from Ottawa, Ontario. Her background includes a wide variety of dance training in jazz, tap, modern, acro, hip hop, as well as an intensive study in ballet, attaining a membership in the Royal Academy of Dance. Mackenzie has 12 years experience in the performing arts industry as a Program Director, Choreographer, Costumes Assistant and Dance Instructor. She created 2 successful dance programs at a community centre and KaliAndrews Dance Company in Ottawa, teaching children between the ages of 2.5–16 years old. Working with children brings Mackenzie so much joy. She has experience working as an Early Childhood Educator, a Camp Counselor, a Nanny and most recently the Youth Engagement Coordinator at the Adoptive Families Association of BC. Mackenzie is excited to share her positive attitude and love for dance with the Boogaloo community!

Kenneth Bulao

Kenneth started dancing at the age of 16 and soon realized his passion for dance would evolve into a rewarding career. Kenneth went onto teach choreography across N. America such as BC, Ontario & Hawaii. In his professional dancing career, Kenneth has competed and placed in many competitions locally & internationally. He has also worked with Lululemon, Vice Magazine and was a feature performer in "This is Yoga Campaign". Kenneth currently resides in Vancouver, training and working as an independent artist. Kenneth's dance style focuses on the intention of movement and varying energy within the move by playing with instrumentals and lyricism.

Eric Cheung

Born and raised in Calgary AB, Eric Cheung is a dance artist who specializes in the street style of popping. Eric is currently working with Ouro Collective and performed last season in the new creation "HAKO". As an artist, Eric strives to show the most authentic version of himself whenever he performs: exposing his truths in his movement and intention. He is passionate about pushing the boundaries of street dance and its possibilities by exploring different domains such as performing in Virtual Reality (VR), creating short films and bringing street dance into a contemporary light. While evolving and developing her dance mainly through freestyle, she enjoys coaching others through the same process and is excited to work with Boogaloo Academy's students to help them discover new elements and forms of expression through Animation.

Shuya Liao

Shuya prides herself on her love for expressive movement. She has been studio trained in hip hop for four years and continues her growth through self-learning. She considers every performance an opportunity to unmask every side of herself through the many styles of hip hop that she has developed during her journey as a dancer. Shuya's personal style of hip hop is more of a fusion, as it takes inspiration primarily from tutting and contemporary dance. However, she believes that dance has no definition, shape or size, but rather it is what allows us to convey who we are and what we feel. Her greatest hope is that she can continue to inspire students by showing them the many styles of street dance one can explore.

Shuya believes that every dancer has a personal style that can be brought out through exploration and training and she is happy to be able to help the students at Boogaloo discover their potential!

Missy Martin

Missy Martin has been teaching dance for over 20 years. She began her career in Prince George where she studied ballet, jazz, contemporary, lyrical, musical theatre. She received her R.A.D Advanced 2 certificate at the age of 16 while dancing the lead role of Clara in the production of the Nutcracker, alongside the Prince George Symphony Orchestra and Ballet BC alumni Edmund Kilpatrick. As a Provincial Rep she was awarded runner up in ballet in 1997 and won the jazz and stage category in 1998. Since moving to Vancouver, Missy has partnered with choreographer Paul Becker–dancing in movies such as Josie and the Pussy Cats, and Life or Something Like it, starring Angelina Jolie. She has also worked with Chris Kattan as a dance stunt double in the film Totally Awesome and has done a National commercials for Macv's. She has worked on the TV show American Dreams with Brittany Snow. She has also taken two large groups to dance in California at Disneyland choreographing the jazz and stage show alongside for Douglas Ballet Academy. Missy is a passionate teacher and taught for Dance Collective (formerly Douglas Ballet Academy) for 18 years, building the jazz programme. Her choreography has won many awards in competitions and has students that have gone on to dance in ballet and jazz companies: some have also become dance instructors. She specializes in teaching jazz, contemporary stage and lyrical, but also teaches ballet, and pointe, youth tap and musical theatre.

Randall Mella

Randall Mella is a dancer, choreographer, performer, instructor and creative director originally from Edmonton, Alberta. He began his training at a young age of 4 with traditional filipino dancing, hip hop, and breakdancing. With a growing love for hip hop and commercial choreography, Randall continued to broaden his training with frequent trips to Los Angeles attending and assisting classes at prestigious studios such as Millennium Dance Complex, KreativMndz Dance Academy, Movement Lifestyle, IMMASpace, and many more. Since then he has explored multiple styles of dance from popping, animation, locking, krump, waacking, house, jazz funk and contemporary all to add to his own unique approach to movement. Randall's career highlights include dancing in Kenny Ortega's Netflix series "Julie and the Phantoms", performing live on televised stage alongside "Lia Cole" for her international tour, choreographing for "Chloe Morgan" for her virtual production, teaching at the "Post Dance Experience" convention, and competing three times at "Hip Hop International" the most internationally recognized hip hop competition! He has also performed for multiple artists such as Tyga, Kid Ink, Rich Brian, and the America's Best Dance Crew Tour. Randall is popularly known for his direction of two professional dance companies: Cool Giraffes and NXG Company, both of which made marks on national and international competition scenes. Cool Giraffes are best known for their 1st place finish at the Canadian Hip Hop Championships and a top 10 finish at Hip Hop International out of 55+ teams. With NXG Company, he was in direction for two consecutive 1st place titles at Artists Emerge
