OUR FACULTY

ANITA PEREL-PANAR, M.A. ARTISTIC DIRECTOR & CO-OWNER

Anita Perel-Panar has been educating children in music, dance and drama for over 30 years. Her fascination with creativity, imagination, inherent motivation, human nature and actualizing human potential led to completing her Bachelor of Arts degrees in English, Music and Drama. She completed her Masters of Arts degree with a thesis on The Development of Artistic Awareness in Children. She has extensive training in Ballet and other forms of dance.

Anita's passion for the arts, coupled with her love for teaching, led her to establish A Star Studio, A Star Productions, A Star Society and Boogaloo Academy.

Her dream to integrate the arts where students can develop their creative, expressive, and physical potential is now a reality. She is thrilled to be working with talented and dedicated teachers who share her vision and join her in providing an excellent education for all of our Boogaloo Academy/A Star Society students.

JHERIC HIZON (B-BOY "TWIST") ARTISTIC DIRECTOR & CO-OWNER

Jheric Hizon is a pioneer in the Vancouver street dance scene, having taught many of Vancouver's hip hop teachers. He maintains a hectic schedule as an international dance instructor, choreographer, adjudicator, and performer.

He was chosen to choreograph and perform in the Vancouver Olympics 2010 Closing Ceremonies. Other performances include: The Black Eyed Peas, Dance Delight, concert openings, Mercedes Benz, Nike Presto, Disney Radio and Ayumi Hamasaki (Japan's Queen of Pop). Apart from dancing, he has appeared in several television shows, commercials, documentaries and a feature film.

Along with his performing career, he's had the privilege of judging and teaching over 30,000 dancers across North America and Southeast Asia at dozens of dance studios, conventions and competitions. Jheric specializes in hip hop and breakin'. He is a member of the Now Or Never Break Dance Crew, who won the title of Canadian Breaking Champions in 2008. They represented Canada, competing with 20 other countries in front of an audience of 25,000 people and placed among the world's best break dance crews at Battle of the Year International Germany (the world's largest break dance battle).

MACKENZIE ANDERSON

Mackenzie Anderson is originally from Ottawa, Ontario. Her background includes a wide variety of dance training in jazz, tap, modern, acro, and hip hop, as well as an intensive study in ballet, attaining a membership in the Royal Academy of Dance. Mackenzie has 12 years experience in the performing arts industry as a Program Director, Choreographer, Costumes Assistant and Dance Instructor. She created 2 successful dance programs at a community centre and KaliAndrews Dance Company in Ottawa, teaching children between the ages of 2.5–16 years old. Working with children brings Mackenzie so much joy. She has experience working as an Early Childhood Educator, a Camp Counselor, a Nanny and most recently the Youth Engagement Coordinator at the Adoptive Families Association of BC. Mackenzie is excited to share her positive attitude and love for dance with the Boogaloo community!

JAYDA BHINDER

Jayda Bhinder is a passionate dancer and performer. She started dancing when she was 6 years old. She trained in many different genres such as Ballet, Jazz, Musical Theatre, Lyrical, Tap, and Hip Hop. At the age of 10 she began to specialize in Hip Hop. Since then Jayda has trained with the top Hip Hop teachers locally and across Canada and the US. Her many styles include waacking, popping, animation, old school and new school. She has entered many battles in Hip Hop and Popping and is a force to be battled with! In 2022 she came top 4 in the Red Bull battle in Vancouver which advanced her to the Red Bull nationals in Toronto. She has taken her unique style to battles across North America including World of Dance Arizona, Monsters Hip Hop, Battlezone and Vancouver street Dance Festival to name a few.

She is also a dynamic performer that has had immense success with her team Megabots and her duo DJC. DJC had the amazing opportunity to compete on season 2 of Canada's Got Talent. They wowed the judges with their skill and chemistry as a dynamic duo!

Jayda has represented Team Canada Hip Hop in Denmark as a junior and is looking forward to representing Team Canada Hip Hop again in 2023 on the adult team.

She enjoys working with younger dancers and choreographing. Jayda has a wide range of hip hop knowledge to share with her students. She is very excited and passionate about growing the next generation of Hip Hop dancers!

JENNA ESCOBIDO

Jenna Escobido trained in hip hop for 8 years at Fresh Groove Productions. She has had the opportunity to perform all over the lower mainland, Disney Land, and has competed and won in many competitions all over North America. She has been teaching and coaching competitive groups for 4 years and teaches at her former high school and multiple elementary schools and preschools. She is very happy to be working with all the amazing dancers at Boogaloo Academy.

ANA XIMENA LIMA MARTINEZ

Ana Ximena was born and raised in México. She began her classical ballet training at a very young age, and her passion for the art form only grew with time. For many years, she attended her local ballet studio under the direction of Alberto Terrero, a former principal dancer with the Cuban National Ballet. Randall Mella is a dancer, choreographer, performer, instructor and creative director originally from Edmonton, Alberta. He began his training at a young age of 4 with traditional filipino dancing, hip hop, and breakdancing. With a growing love for hip hop and commercial choreography, Randall continued to broaden his training with frequent trips to Los Angeles. Since then, he has explored multiple styles of dance from popping, animation, locking, krump, waacking, house, jazz funk and contemporary all to add to his own unique approach to movement. He has trained closely and mentored under prestigious choreographers such as Alexander Chung, Carlo Atienza, Diana Matos, Free Boogie, Anze Skrube, and many more.

Randall’s career highlights include dancing in Kenny Ortega’s Netflix series “Julie and the Phantoms”, performing live on televised stage alongside “Lia Cole” for her international tour, choreographing for “Chloe Morgan” for her virtual production, teaching at the “Post Dance Experience” convention, and competing three times at “Hip Hop International” the most internationally recognized hip hop competition! He has also performed for multiple artists such as Tyga, Kid Ink, Rich Brian, and the America’s Best Dance Crew Tour. Randall is popularly known for his direction of two professional dance companies: Cool Giraffes and NXG Company, both of which made marks on national and international competition scenes. Cool Giraffes are best known for their 1st place finish at the Canadian Hip Hop Championships and a top 10 finish at Hip Hop International out of 55+ teams. With NXG Company, he was in direction for two consecutive 1st place titles at Artists Emerge

All-Stars, 1st place finish at World of Dance Edmonton and choreographed for the “ENERGY” show in Los Angeles produced by Alexander Chung and Gina Pero.

Randall’s mission is to utilize his love for dance and creative direction to inspire anyone with a passion to pursue their wildest dreams. Through positivity and authenticity balanced with hard work and dedication, he strives to influence other artists to work to their highest potential and accomplish their own incredible feats in order to help live out and further his mission.

Amanda is from Calgary, Alberta, where she began dancing at the age of 3. She has 18 years of dance experience and 8 years of competing at dance competitions with her studio.
