ANITA PEREL-PANAR, M.A.

ARTISTIC DIRECTOR & CO-OWNER

Anita Perel-Panar has been educating children in music, dance and drama for over 30 years. Her fascination with creativity, imagination, inherent motivation, human nature and actualizing human potential led to completing her Bachelor of Arts degrees in English, Music and Drama. She completed her Masters of Arts degree with a thesis on The Development of Artistic Awareness in Children. She has extensive training in Ballet and other forms of dance.

Anita's passion for the arts, coupled with her love for teaching, led her to establish A Star Studio, A Star Productions, A Star Society and Boogaloo Academy.

Her dream to integrate the arts where students can develop their creative, expressive, and physical potential is now a reality. She is thrilled to be working with talented and dedicated teachers who share her vision and join her in providing an excellent education for all of our Boogaloo Academy/A Star Society students.

JHERIC HIZON (B-BOY "TWIST")

ARTISTIC DIRECTOR & CO-OWNER

Jheric Hizon is a pioneer in the Vancouver street dance scene, having taught many of Vancouver's hip hop teachers. He maintains a hectic schedule as an international dance instructor, choreographer, adjudicator, and performer.

He was chosen to choreograph and perform in the Vancouver Olympics 2010 Closing Ceremonies. Other performances include: The Black Eyed Peas, Dance Delight, concert openings, Mercedes Benz, Nike Presto, Disney Radio and Ayumi Hamasaki (Japan's Queen of Pop). Apart from dancing, he has appeared in several television shows, commercials, documentaries and a feature film.

Along with his performing career, he's had the privilege of judging and teaching over 30,000 dancers across North America and Southeast Asia at dozens of dance studios, conventions and competitions. Jheric specializes in hip hop and breakin'. He is a member of the Now Or Never Break Dance Crew, who won the title of Canadian Breaking Champions in 2008. They represented Canada, competing with 20 other countries in front of an audience of 25,000 people and placed among the world's best break dance crews at Battle of the Year International Germany (the world's largest break dance battle).

MACKENZIE ANDERSON Mackenzie Anderson is originally from Ottawa, Ontario. Her background includes a wide variety of dance training in jazz, tap, modern, acro, hip hop, as well as an intensive study in ballet, attaining a membership in the Royal Academy of Dance.

Mackenzie has 12 years experience in the performing arts industry as a Program Director, Choreographer, Costumes Assistant and Dance Instructor. She created 2 successful dance programs at a community centre and KaliAndrews Dance Company in Ottawa, teaching children between the ages of 2.5–16 years old.

Working with children brings Mackenzie so much joy. She has experience working as an Early Childhood Educator, a Camp Counselor, a Nanny and most recently the Youth Engagement Coordinator at the Adoptive Families Association of BC. Mackenzie is new to Vancouver and excited to share her positive attitude and love for dance with the Boogaloo community!

ERIC CHEUNG Born and raised in Calgary AB, Eric Cheung is a dance artist who specializes in the street style of popping. Eric is currently working with Ouro Collective and performed last season in the new creation "HAKO". As an artist, Eric strives to show the most authentic version of himself whenever he performs: exposing his truths in his movement and intention. He is passionate about pushing the boundaries of street dance and its possibilities by exploring different domains such as performing in Virtual Reality (VR), creating short films and bringing street dance into a contemporary light. Eric is thrilled to be working with all the amazing dancers at Boogaloo Academy.

JENNA ESCOBIDO Jenna Escobido trained in hip hop for 8 years at Fresh Groove Productions. She has had the opportunity to perform all over the lower mainland, Disney Land, and has competed and won in many competitions all over North America. She has been teaching and coaching competitive groups for 4 years and teaches at her former high school and multiple elementary schools and preschools. She is very happy to be working with all the amazing dancers at Boogaloo Academy.

SHUYA LIAO Shuya prides herself on her love for expressive movement. She has been studio trained in hip hop for four years and continues her growth through self-learning. She considers every performance an opportunity to unmask every side of herself through the many styles of hip hop that she has developed during her journey as a dancer. Shuya's personal style of hip hop is more of a fusion, as it takes inspiration primarily from tutting and contemporary dance. However, she believes that dance has no definition, shape or size, but rather it is what allows us to convey who we are and what we feel. Her greatest hope is that she can continue to inspire students by showing them the many styles of street dance one can explore.

Shuya believes that every dancer has a personal style that can be brought out through exploration and training and she is happy to be able to help the students at Boogaloo discover their potential!

MISSY MARTIN Missy Martin has been teaching dance for over 20 years. She began her career in Prince George where she studied ballet, jazz, contemporary, lyrical, musical theatre. She received her R.A.D Advanced 2 certificate at the age of 16 while dancing the lead role of Clara in the production of the Nutcracker, alongside the Prince George Symphony Orchestra and Ballet BC alumni Edmund Kilpatrick. As a Provincial Rep she was awarded runner up in ballet in 1997 and won the jazz and stage category in 1998. Since moving to Vancouver, Missy has partnered with choreographer Paul Becker—dancing in movies such as Josie and the Pussy Cats, and Life or Something Like it, starring Angelina Jolie. She has also worked with Chris Kattan as a dance stunt double in the film Totally Awesome and has done a National commercials for Macy's. She has worked on the TV show

American Dreams with Brittany Snow. She has also taken two large groups to dance in California at Disneyland choreographing the jazz and stage show alongside for Douglas Ballet Academy. Missy is a passionate teacher and taught for Dance Collective (formerly Douglas Ballet Academy) for 18 years, building the jazz programme. Her choreography has won many awards in competitions and has students that have gone on to dance in ballet and jazz companies: some have also become dance instructors. She specializes in teaching jazz, contemporary stage and lyrical, but also teaches ballet, and pointe, youth tap and musical theatre.

SHERYL MCMILLAN From Musical Theatre to Children's Theatre, from Dinner Theatre to film & television, Sheryl Anne has been part of the entertainment industry for 30+ years—performing, impersonating, choreographing, directing and teaching.

Sheryl has toured extensively throughout Australia as a member of the Vocal Quartet "Strictly Vocal" and has several CD recordings under her belt. While in Australia, Sheryl was a main performer at Brentleigh Theatre Restaurant before becoming resident choreographer until they closed their doors in 2002. During her time in Australia, Sheryl was also resident vocal coach for two dance studios in Brisbane over the course of 5 years.

Roll back several years where Sheryl's training and skills as a young performer were honed at Theatre Under the Stars, the Arts Club and Carousel Theatre, Harbour Dance Centre and Mailinko Ballet. She attended The American Academy of Dramatic Arts in NYC as well as Western Washington University's Summer stock theatre program.

Recent Theatrical credits for Theatre Under The Stars include: "Rosie" in Mama Mia, "Mrs. Brill" in Mary Poppins and "Mrs. Tottendale" in The Drowsy Chaperone. Sheryl was also seen as Mrs. Potts in Beauty and the Beast at TUTS in 2016. She has received the Aida Broadbent Award for Professional Conduct and Performance and is a recipient of the E.V.Young Award two times in a row for Most Outstanding Performance by an Actress.

Sheryl joined Lindbjerg Academy this year but has been teaching Musical Theatre and voice both here in Canada and Australia for

many years...too many to count. No stranger to the Tri-Cities area, Sheryl was a regular performer at Maz N Me's Dinner Theatre Restaurant in Port Coquitlam and taught Musical Theatre and Voice at 4 different schools within the New Westminster School District as part of their after-school program.

SAMANTHA PENNER Samantha is a dancer, instructor, and choreographer, with a BFA degree in Dance from Simon Fraser University. Among other styles, she is trained in contemporary, modern, lyrical, jazz, technique, ballet, musical theatre/stage, improvisation, composition, and movement analysis. Through SFU, Samantha has trained and performed works by Vanessa Goodman, Wen Wei Wang, Yossi & Oded Dance Theatre, Lesley Telford, and many more.

Samantha's passion for dance shines through her students: she has taught students from age 2–19, both competitive and recreational. In 2016, she had the opportunity to create a contemporary piece for the opening ceremonies of the BC Summer Games, which was performed for an audience of 8,000 spectators.

Samantha has a deep desire to immerse young dancers in the love of the arts, and she believes that being involved in the arts has a profound impact on the development of children and teenagers. She is excited to be a part of the Boogaloo team!

SAMANTHA PRESLEY Samantha is a dynamic performer, instructor, artist, and scholarship recipient who is most fulfilled when she is active and creating meaningful art within the community. Samantha has a BFA, majoring in Dance, and has studied contemporary, ballet, and various modern dance techniques extensively at Simon Fraser's School for the Contemporary Arts. She premiered her first full length show in 2016 entitled "Playful Parameters"; and remounted it later that year for the SFU FCAT conference, where she also gave a talk on her process of creating dances that are inspired by the movement patterns and unique behaviors of young children.

Samantha is passionate about sharing her love for movement, health and fitness, while acting as a role model inspiring personal growth and confidence in her students.

FRANKIE WARREN Frankie Warren graduated from the University of Calgary with a BFA specializing in dance; and then moved to Vancouver to further her dance career. Some of Frankie's major achievements have been lead dancer in the "IOU2" visual album, released by Lido (LA artist), choreographer for the Body Gold music video by Lozen Music (Vancouver artist), dancer and choreographer for the 2018 IGNITE Festival, and choreographer and dancer in an Onni Group Realtor video Listed by Sawyer + Brandon. Frankie has also worked with renowned choreographers such as Luther Brown, Peggy Baker, and Cirque du Soleil, and has a passion for performing and directing in TV and film. Frankie is thrilled to be sharing her knowledge, passion and creativity with the athletes and artists at Boogaloo Academy.

SARAH PO TING YEUNG Born in Hong Kong, Sarah started her ballet training at the Jean M. Wong School of Ballet at the age of 3. While she trained there, in 2005, Sarah received the Dame Margot Fonteyn Award from the Tsinforn C. Wong Memorial Scholarship to attend the Hamburg Ballet School in Germany. After she graduated, she danced with Dreseden Semper Oper Ballet, Germany and Dutch National Ballet, Holland and returned to Hong Kong in 2010 to complete further study at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts. She joined the Hong Kong Ballet in 2010 and in 2015 she joined the Royal Winnipeg Ballet, Canada.

Over her 10-year professional experience, she performed in many national theaters, including China, England, Germany, Holland, Spain, Italy, France, US and Canada and she was featured in major roles in classical productions like Big Swan in Swan Lake, Mercedes in Don Quixote, and the Sugar Plum Fairy in the Nutcracker. Sarah worked with many world famous contemporary choreographers including: John Neumeier, Jorma Elo, David Dawson, James Kudelka, Krzysztof Pastor, Terence Koehler, Mark Gordon, Peter Quanz, Kinsun Chan, Li Jun and Yuri Ng. Sarah has been sharing her passion for dance and movement with students since 2010 and has experience in teaching a wide variety of styles to students of all ages. Sarah believes dance is for everyone and loves sharing her knowledge and experience with everyone at Boogaloo Academy.
